The 2006 Las Vegas Reunion is just around the corner. Normally, the reunion is in September, however at the 1996 Colorado Springs Reunion, it was voted on by the General Membership every third year the reunion would be in August. THE NEW ORLEANS HOTEL in Las Vegas is asking each member in the making of hotel reservations to call 1-800-675- 3267, Mon-Fri 7:00AM – 11:00PM or Sat-Sun 7:00AM – 5:00PM and identify yourself as an attendee for the FRA Conference, August 23rd – August 27th. We have blocked off 150 rooms at the current rate of \$69 Wednesday & Thursday and \$119 Friday & Saturday. This includes tax and there is no charge for parking. There is motor home parking without hookup. The CUTOFF DATE FOR OUR ROOM BLOCK IS JULY 21st. PLEASE TRY AND MAKE YOUR ROOM RESERVATION ASAP.

We have negotiated with an independent company to transport member's round trip from the airport to the hotel for \$13. Those who chose to use this service can find it at the MAIN TERMINAL BAGGAGE CLAIM LEVEL, DOOR 13. The name of their booth is ShowTime TOURS 1-702-933-3388.

All guests coming to the Reunion must be registered as a guest on the FRA Registration Form. NO EXCEPTIONS.
